

Information about visa

A visa application is lodged at the diplomatic missions or consular posts of Romania competent in the area of domicile or residence of the applicant.

We strongly recommend you to lodge the application two weeks before the expected date of arrival in the Romania.

Taking into account the purpose of the journey you will apply for **The short-stay visa for cultural, scientific and humanitarian activities, as well as short-term medical treatment or any other activities that do not breach Romanian laws (marked C/ZA)** – this type of short-stay visa is issued to third-country nationals who wish to travel to Romania, provided that their presence on the territory of Romania is justified.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS FOR THE Short-Stay Visa for Cultural, Scientific and Humanitarian Activities, as well as Short-Term Medical Treatment or Any Other Activities That Do Not Breach Romanian Laws (marked C/ZA):

Supporting Document	Description
VALID TRAVEL DOCUMENT	A valid travel document accepted by Romania, on which a visa can be affixed. The validity of the travel document must exceed the validity of the visa you apply for, by at least 3 months, and must have been issued no later than 10 years ago.
PHOTOGRAPHS	Two recent 3 x 4 cm coloured photographs
TRAVEL MEDICAL INSURANCE	Travel medical insurance that covers the entire duration of the requested period of stay
SUPPORTING DOCUMENT REGARDING THE PURPOSE OF THE JOURNEY	Invitation issued by the institution the third-state national intends to travel to, so as to justify the necessity of the journey to Romania
VEHICLE SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS	Valid driver's license, Green Card (International Motor Insurance Card) and registration documents of the means of transport for vehicle drivers.
TRAVEL TICKET	Valid airplane ticket valid to destination
MEANS OF SUPPORT	Proof of means of support at the level of the minimum guaranteed gross salary, for the entire period specified in the visa.
ACCOMMODATION	Voucher or firm reservation with a tourist accommodation resort or, proof of accommodation being ensured by the host company, if the case should be.

Visa processing fees: In accordance with the provisions of the legislation in force, visa processing fees for - Short-stay visa (marked C) is 60 EUR.

NOTA BENE

STARTING JULY 11TH 2014, ROMANIA APPLIES THE PROVISIONS OF DECISION NO. 565/2014/EU OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL, THEREFORE IF YOU FIT INTO ONE OF THE SITUATIONS BELOW, YOU ARE EXEMPT FROM THE ROMANIAN VISA REQUIREMENT, FOR STAYS OF NO MORE THAN 90 DAYS DURING ANY 180-DAY PERIOD:

The holders of Schengen visas with two or multiple entries, national visas or residence permits issued by Schengen Member States.

Attention! The number of entries as well as the right of stay established as per the Schengen visas must not have been exhausted. The right of stay on the territory of Romania shall not exceed the right of stay granted as per the visas/residence permits issued by the Schengen Member States.

The holders of **permanent residence** permits issued by the UK or Ireland. The right of stay on the territory of Romania shall not exceed the right of stay granted as per such residence permits.

The holders of visas or residence permits issued by Bulgaria, Cyprus or Croatia.

Attention! The number of entries as well as the right of stay established as per such visas must not have been exhausted. The right of stay on the territory of Romania shall not exceed the right of stay granted as per such visas/residence permits.

The holders of small border traffic permits issued by Romanian authorities, whenever they exercise their right to circulation as per the small border traffic regime.
